

GENERAL INFORMATION

Application and ReEnrollment Fee: The application fee is paid the first time a family applies and is non-refundable unless ACA is unable to enroll the student. The registration fee is paid each successive year at re-enrollment.

- Application fee per new family \$175.00
(Includes one Yearbook per family)
- ReEnrollment fee per current family \$175.00
(Includes one Yearbook per family)

Testing Fees:

- Entrance testing for all Kindergarten applicants
(due day of test) \$40.00
- Entrance testing for all applicants Grades 1 – 12
(due day of test) \$50.00

Parent-Partners Academy Fee..... \$300.00

New families enrolling at ACA are charged a \$300 fee for Parent-Partners Academy. ACA believes so strongly in the parent/school partnership that upon enrollment, new parents are required to participate in a two-session Parent-Partners Academy. Upon completion of both sessions, \$300 will be credited back to the family's account.

A 10% Reservation Deposit is required on June 1 in order to secure the child's placement. If acceptance occurs after June 1, the deposit is required upon acceptance.

Payment Options:

- **One Advance Payment** of the full amount (after 10% deposit) must be received by August 15 of the current school year. Please deduct \$50.00 from the full amount for this option.
- **Two equal Payments** are due (first half due August 15; second half due January 1).
- **Monthly Payments** begin in June prior to the start of school. The full amount must be paid by May 1 of the following year. Arrangements for this option are made through the Business Office.

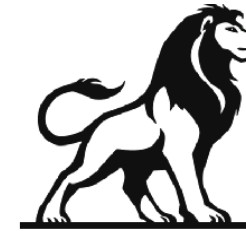
