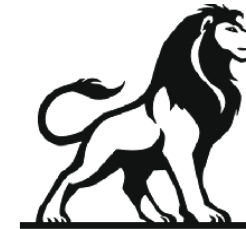

GENERAL INFORMATION

Non-Refundable Application Fee (per family)\$175.00
 The application fee covers the admissions process and is non-refundable unless ACA is unable to enroll the student.

Entrance Testing

- **Kindergarten Screening** (required).....no charge
- **Grades 1-5** (required)\$50.00
- **Grades 6-12** (upon request of admissions committee)..... \$50.00

Enrollment Deposit..... \$500.00
 Upon acceptance new families will be given 30 days to acknowledge placement and remit the deposit. The deposit is applied toward tuition costs. Acceptances prior to February 1 will be due March 1.

Parent-Partners Academy Fee.....\$300.00
 New families enrolling at ACA are charged a \$300 Parent-Partners Academy fee. ACA believes so strongly in the parent/school partnership that upon enrollment, new parents are requested to participate in a two-session Parent-Partners Academy. After completing both sessions, the \$300 is credited back to the family's account.

Payment Options: The Business Office will issue to new families a tuition contract for the remaining balance upon receipt of the Enrollment Deposit. Payment options are:

- **One Advance Payment** of the full amount payable by August 15 of the current school year.
- **Two equal Payments** are due (first half payable by August 15; second half payable by January 1).
- **Monthly Payments** begin in June prior to the start of school. The full amount must be paid by May 1 of the following year.

Tuition and Fees cover textbooks, classroom materials, student accident insurance and activity fees (i.e. field trips, auxiliary learning experiences, retreats, etc.).

Tuition Assistance:

The board of Asheville Christian Academy is committed to making ACA as financially accessible as possible to any Christian family desiring a Christ-centered liberal arts education for their children. At this time approximately 40% of our families receive assistance. An average award is 30%.

Awards are given only after a family has been accepted; therefore, **families desiring tuition assistance** are strongly urged to submit applications for admission by March 1 to allow for sufficient time to complete the admissions process.

Families desiring need-based assistance are encouraged to apply through *FACTS Grant & Aid Assessment* and should plan to request an application or apply online www.factstuitionaid.com after February 1. It is imperative that interested parties apply by the **April 1 deadline**. Families will be notified of financial aid beginning May 1. (*Requests received after April 1 will be awarded according to available funds*).
